Here is the picture and some details: 1945? Yates American 36" Bandsaw. Bought from Don Peterson @ Vintage American Woodworking Machinery. It is now 220 volt single phase. The electric motor is 7.5 hp. The piece weighs about 3,000 lbs. I bought it (2006) and had it completely restored for \$7,500. This is about what a new 36" Laguna or Model 900 Agazanni would cost; only this is a lot more stable. Lightly used since restoral.
